Somerset Trust Company Receives 2019 National Community Bank Service Award

Somerset Trust Company received the 2019 National Community Bank Service Award on November 14, 2019 in a formal award presentation ceremony at their Historic Trust Department building in Somerset, PA. The Independent Community Bankers of America® (ICBA) selected Somerset Trust from a group of 100 nominations for its impactful Champion of First Responders program, which supports volunteer fire departments and EMS organizations throughout its service area.

"For more than two decades Somerset Trust has championed first responders, who help ensure the health and safety of our citizens and local businesses, contributing to a vibrant and thriving community," said G. Henry Cook, CEO and Chairman of the Board at Somerset Trust Company. "We are grateful for ICBA's recognition and thankful for the privilege to support one of the most vital and prevalent public service needs in the rural communities we serve."

Since 2013, the \$1.3 billion-asset bank has approved more than \$7.4 million in financing for volunteer fire departments, typically at special nonprofit rates. In addition, the bank makes annual donations in excess of \$35,000 to 60 local fire departments. It also sponsors several events designed to raise awareness and honor the sacrifices of these brave men and women, including its ongoing #STCGives social media campaign. This campaign has connected with more than 42,000 users and promoted a bank-produced tribute video featuring fire chiefs, captains, and local fire department presidents. Each spring, bank volunteers also participate in "Plant a Tree at Flight 93," a reforestation effort that will result in 150,000 new trees at the Flight 93 National Memorial in Somerset County, Pa.



More than 100 community banks have been recognized since ICBA launched the National Community Bank Service Award program in 2002. Somerset Trust and other award recipients were featured in the September issue of Independent Banker® magazine.
